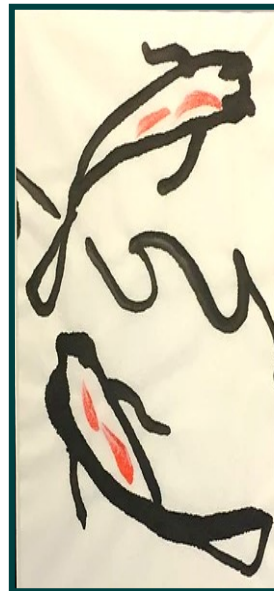

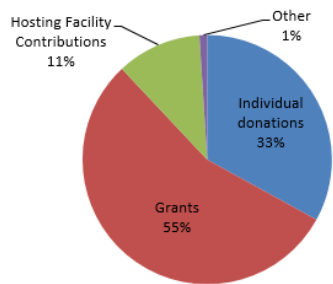

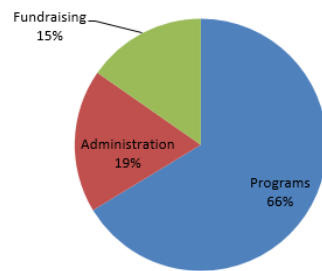

### Executive Director's Report

2018 was a milestone year for Seniors Creating Art due to the expansion of programs to eastern Washington! In 2018, SCA programs expanded to east of the mountains to Yakima. This is where the 2nd round of artwork was created for the Travelling Mural Exhibit, a project done in collaboration with the Art of Alzheimer's. 2018 also marks the year our first contract was established with the King County Library System. This contract opened the door to SCA providing art programs at the 35 different King County Libraries. SCA closed out 2018 by reaching the milestone of raising over \$100,000, since inception, for art programs and supplies for senior citizens. We couldn't have done it without you! 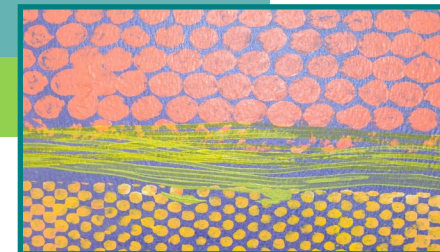
